### **\*THE NICENE CREED**

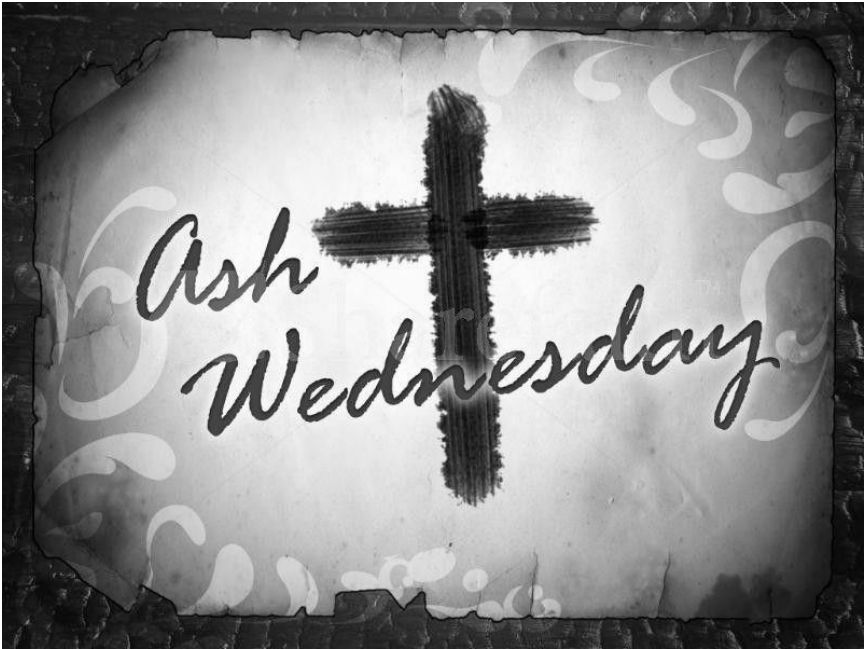
